Fiji is famous for the variety of activities available. These include snorkelling over shallow reefs close to shore, diving, which offers a full range of a underwater experience, riding in a jetboat, trekking in the tropical rainforests, swimming in the crystal clear waters of a rushing river, or can even visit a sacred cave? How about a shopping tour of Suva, or a special week-long excursion around the major island where you can pilot a raft through raging rapids, sail through the magnificence of the Yasawa island chain or safari into the highlands to see rugged peaks and remote villages... Fiji has it all.

Nadi town is a 10-minute car ride from Nadi International Airport. It is the focal point of the many hotels and resorts within the region. Nearby is Denarau Island with its luxurious resorts, championship golf course and marina - A gateway to cruises and boating activities. Nadi is a convenient location from which to explore Viti Levu and the nearby Mamanuca and Yasawa Islands.

Mamanuca Islands are set among deep blue waters with fringing coral reefs of turquoise and pastel green, these islands and the islands of Nadi bay offer tourists some of Fiji's most outstanding island beauty. Home to more than a dozen resorts; their close proximity to Nadi allows access by boat, plane (including Seaplane) and Helicopter. Other outer islands include Kadavu, some 50 miles south of Suva, Ovalau the former capital, Levuka, and the outer islands including the famous Vatulele Island. There is a wide range of accommodation to suit all tastes. A number of resorts specialise in scuba diving on the world renowned Astrolabe Reef.

Yasawa Islands offers a wide range of accommodation to suit all tastes, including village-based hotels, stunning white beaches and crystal clear lagoons. They are a chain of 20 ancient volcanic islands, which some of these have dramatic elevations with summits. 'Yasawa' one of the Fijian words for heaven.

The Coral Coast starts approximately 20kms south of Nadi town and stretches for more than 100 kms to Pacific Harbour. It is the home to some of Fiji's best-known hotels and resorts. The Queens road runs through cane fields, pine forests and along spectacular stretches of lagoons and beaches. Coconut palms, secluded bays and beaches, villages and secluded places where the visitor can stop to admire the view or take refreshments. Make this one of Fiji's favourite holiday destinations. The main town on the way is Sigatoka, which has a wide range of facilities such as shopping – for locals and tourists, entertainment, sporting facilities, health and medical services, transportation and communications.

Pacific Harbour was developed as a complete visitor destination with its own 18-hole championship golf course, and inland waterway (where owners of luxury villas moor their pleasure craft), hotels, a shopping centre in the late 19th century style and a cultural centre. The nearby island of Beqa (pronounced Benga), home of the legendary firewalkers, is a world-renowned diving location and also has a resort. Diving, fishing, sailing, golf, tennis, horse riding and a host of other activities await the visitor.

Suva, the capital of Fiji, was developed in the late 1800's and retains much of the character of the colonial period. Its many attraction include shopping, restaurants, nightclubs, markets, museum, sightseeing tours, and the Orchid Island Cultural Centre. An international Airport also services Suva with direct services from Sydney and local services within the Fiji group.

Etiquette in A Fijian Village

When visiting a village it is customary to present a gift of yaqona, which is also known as kava. The gift, called a sevusevu, is not expensive-half-a-kilo (which is appropriate) costs approximately \$10.

It is presented to the Turaga ni Koro, the executive head of the village. The presentation is usually in his house and will generally be attended by some of the older men who happen to be in the vicinity at the time and can quickly turn into a social occasion. Pounded into powder, the yaqona will be mixed with water and served. Be prepared to shake hands and to answer many personal questions such as where you are from, are you married, how many children do you have and so on.

It is important to dress modestly when away from the immediate vicinity of your resort or hotel. Always carry a sulu (sarong, lavalava, pareu) to cover bathing togs or shorts and halter-tops.

Do not wear a hat in a village as it is considered an insult to a chief. Do not wear shoes into people's houses. It is considered an insult to touch someone's head. Fijians are known as the friendliest people in the world. Your respect for their customs and traditions will not only make you a welcome guest in their villages and homes, but also add another dimension to your Fijian holiday.

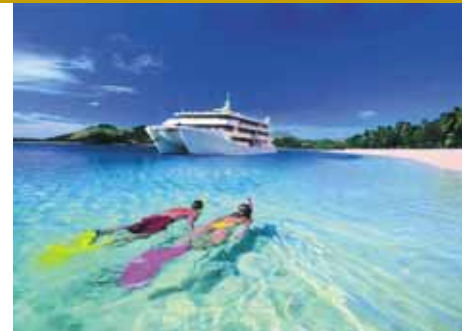
