ANGKOR TEMPLES TOUR

Full Day

Transfer from your hotel to the Angkor temple complex.

Visit the antique capital of Angkor Thom (12th century). See the stunning South Gate, the Elephant Terrace & the Terrace of the Leper king. Also visit the Bayon Temple – unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces. In the late morning visit Ta Prohm – a beautiful jungle temple that has been relatively untouched since it was discovered & retains much of its mystery.

In the afternoon visit the most famous of all the temples – Angkor Wat. Covering 81 hectares, it has five distinct peaks & is considered by art historians to be the prime example of classical Khmer art & architecture. Visiting Angkor Wat is an experience you will remember for the rest of your life.

Transfer back to your hotel

TONLE SAP LAKE TOUR

Half Day

Transfer from your hotel to Chong Khneas

Visit the floating village of Chong Khneas located 10 kilometres south of Siem Reap. Since the most ancient times, fishermen have lived on the 'Great Lake' in perfect harmony with nature, setting stilted villages along the shores & gathering in 'floating villages'. From here you will take a traditional wooden boat for a ride on the Tonle Sap Lake – one of the largest lakes in Asia. Tonle Sap is connected to the Mekong River and, with the rainy season, the flow of the mighty Mekong rises until it forces the Tonle Sap River to reverse its course, a natural cycle which is unique to Cambodia. Amazingly, the Tonle Sap River expands to over 4 times its normal size in the wet season. This swelling & flooding of the river, and the surrounding forests, attracts millions of fish & a myriad of waterbirds.

Transfer from the 'Great Lake' to your hotel.

Included in the tour price: Transfers by private air-conditioned vehicle. Services of a local English-speaking guide. Boat fee.

Not included in the tour price: Personal expenditure such as drinks, souvenirs, etc.

PHNOM PENH CITY TOUR

Half Day

Begin your tour of this charming capital city with a visit to the city's namesake, Wat Phnom.

Founded in 1373, the pagoda was built to house Buddhist relics washed ashore by the river. From here you will visit the Royal Palace built in 1866 by King Norodom. The amazing pagoda-style architecture is set among the beautiful Royal Palace gardens. Next is a visit to the Silver Pagoda so named because of its floor that is comprised of 5,000 silver tiles. A gold Buddha encrusted with 9,584 diamonds and a small 17th century emerald and baccarat crystal Buddha are also housed here. Finally you will visit the nearby National Museum. Built in 1917, it is an exceptional example of traditional architecture and is exclusively devoted to preserving and displaying Khmer art and sculptures. Hundreds of pieces are housed here including both pre & post-Angkorian pieces.

Note: National Museum, Silver pagoda & Royal Palace are open every day. However, the Silver Pagoda & the Royal Palace may be closed without prior notice while H.M the King is in the residence.

Extended Tours

MAGIC ANGKOR WAT TOUR

2 Day/1 Night

A short, overnight tour perfect for exploring the highlights of the region.

Day 1: Transfer from your hotel to the Angkor Complex. The morning will be spent discovering these ancient ruins that have been standing for over 1000 years. Visit the ancient capital of Angkor Thom (12th century), the famous South Gate, the fascinating Bayon Temple, the Royal Enclosure, Phimeanakas, the Elephants Terrace & the Terrace of the Leper King.

The afternoon is dedicated to the exploration of one of the Seven Modern Wonders of the World – the temple of Angkor Wat. Sunset will be at Angkor Wat or from Phnom Bakheng, one of the two hills dominating the plain of Angkor – from where you will have a spectacular view.

Day 2: In the morning you will continue your temple visits, including the unique brick sculptures of Prasat Kravan, the mountain temple of Pre Rup, Ta Som, Neak Pean and the

wonderful Eastern Mebon – which is guarded at its corner by stone figures of harnessed elephants. In the afternoon you will visit 2 amazing temples – Preah Khan and Ta Prohm – which are of similar style with their towered enclosures & shoulder-hugging corridors. What differs between them is that Preah Khan is in a reasonable state of preservation with ongoing restoration whereas Ta Prohm has been left relatively untouched since its discovery, making it incredibly mysterious.

Transfer back to your hotel **.
